

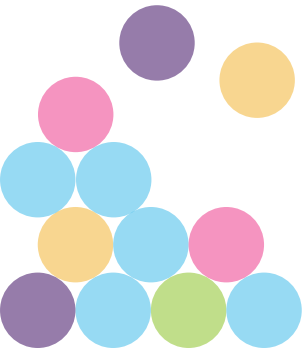
Join our stakeholders group
